# INTRODUCTION



We launched a mass participation programme called All Stars Cricket in 2017, a fully inclusive programme aimed at giving 5 - 8 years olds the best first experience of the game. The programme and activities centre around holistic child development, with participants encouraged to focus on their personal best.

We would love for more girls to feel they can enjoy the opportunities available to them by getting involved at their nearest ASC centres. To support this we have created an 'All Stars Cricket - I tried Cricket badge', introducing them to the programme and showing what they can achieve.

There are two badges available and we have outlined what's required to achieve them. What's more, if they sign up to their nearest ASC centre, they'll be able to collect another 8 badges across the programme.



# I TRIED CRICKET BADGE....



- There are two badges available for girls to collect with the details of what's required included below
  - Whilst the badge is primarily aimed at girls aged 5 8, those at the top end of Brownies are still welcome to participate
- I Tried Cricket badge
  - Delivered at your unit venue
  - Can be delivered across one or two sessions depending on time available (total 1hr needed)
  - Four ASC games
  - Volcanoes & Craters
  - Space Race
  - Star Skills
  - Orbit Bowling
- I Tried All Stars Cricket badge
  - Activities delivered at a local All Stars Cricket centre
  - Opportunity to run festival type activity with multiple units and girls involved
  - Activities will be delivered by Club Activators and/or CCB coaches alongside Unit leaders and volunteers
- Equipment: please see next steps for more information



Sessions should last no longer than an hour with each activity running for around 15 minutes. If your girls are struggling then please adapt the session to keep it as fun as possible with ideas on how to do this included on the activity card.

# THE SPACE RACE



### **COMPETITION CORNER**

Working in pairs and having a time limit to meet as many planets as possible will create a more exciting and competitive game.


